Hi everyone, what a lovely week and the sun has shone on us too!

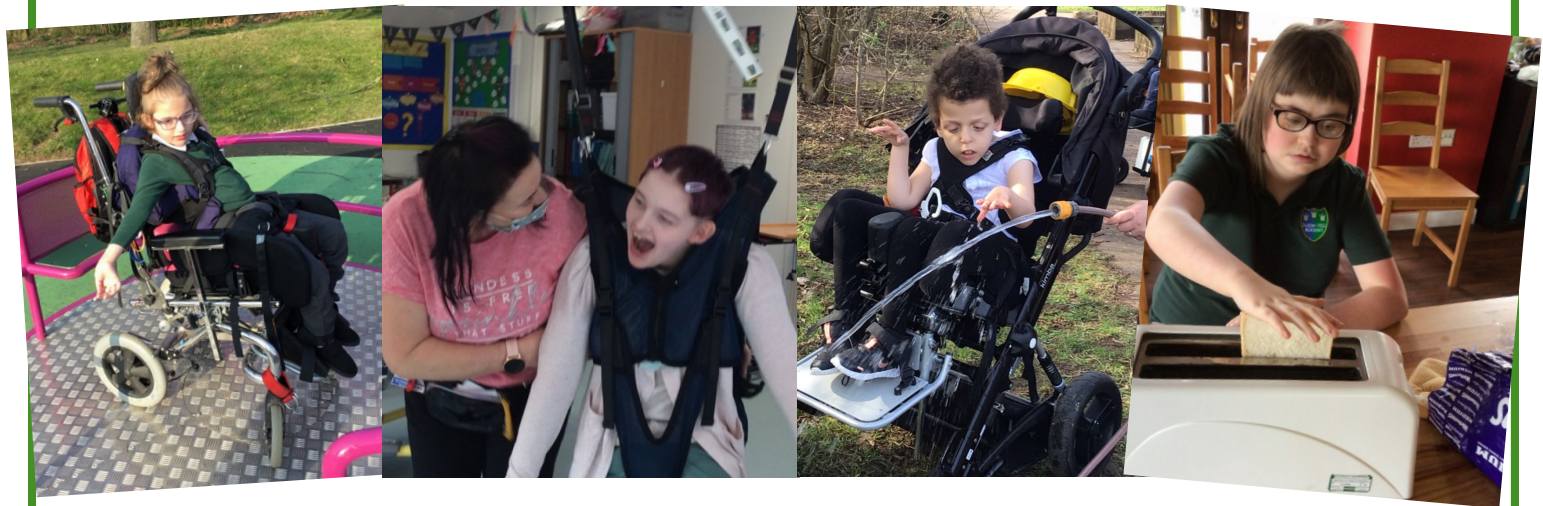
