Hello everyone, welcome back to our weekly Family Update. We respectfully waited until the period of national mourning was over before sharing our celebrations with you again. As a result, this is an extra long edition with important updates and celebrations.

You may already be aware that Staffordshire Local Authority are starting two separate reviews this term. I have already mentioned the LA review of residential provision and now is the time for me to ask for your help and support on this one to SOS; Save Our Sleepover. Everybody understands the need for extra support for all children with EHCPs but not all these children have the same complex needs as our children and young people. The Local Authority are suggesting that residential provision is unfair as it is not available to everyone with an EHCP. We need to show that this is not fair! So many of our children are unable to access any other facilities, activities and opportunities due to their complex disabilities - Sleepover gives, and has given the opportunity to so many children over the years, to develop their social, communication and independence skills and I know that families really appreciate the break knowing that trained, experienced staff are supporting and caring for their child as they would themselves. If you are able to support our cause, even in some small way, or have any views or ideas to put to us, I'd love to hear from you on this quick form: SOS Save Our Sleepover!

There is also a wider review of special education provision across the county and this could affect your child's school placement. We have had nothing shared with us so far but the review will be launched on Monday 3rd October, online at 4pm. 



Speech and Language Taster Workshops

The workshop will be aimed particularly at children in the early years but will be relevant for parents of children with speech and language difficulties.

The session will cover:

- why communication is important
