Hi everyone,

It's been a festive week for us here at Saxon Hill, starting with some early snow and a donated Christmas tree on Monday, and the week will end with a bang as it is our **Christmas Fayre** here in school tomorrow from 1 - 4pm. **Friends of Saxon Hill** have worked very hard on preparations for a fantastic family day out for all our school community. We hope you can join us, please wear a mask indoors so that everyone can feel confident they are helping to keep themselves and others safe. We currently have LFT positive Covid cases who are isolating at home as a precaution, but as yet are unconfirmed with PCR tests. Clearly this virus spreads well given the chance; if your child or anyone in the family has Covid symptoms, please could I ask that you keep your child off school for the 10 days or at least until a negative PCR result is obtained?

Mainstream Secondary schools have been asked to test pupils on-site during the first week back in January, taking 1 test on-site and another 3 to 4 days later [Schools Week]. Due to the additional complex needs of our pupils, we shall not be testing pupils on-site but we can offer LFT testing devices to families who are willing to test their children before they return in January and during their first week back. Also please let us know if you would like our support with a room and LFT devices if you would prefer to test your own child here in school.

The Hornbeam elves will get busy printing and assembling them.






#### **Christmas Jumper Day**
