Updates

What a lovely week the children have had this week. On Wednesday we celebrated 'My Voice Matters' by putting on a range of relaxing and fun activities, recognising Children's Mental Health Week. Children engaged in sessions of Soundbath, Pampering, Dancing Like no-one is Watching, Messy Art, Singing and Signing, Outdoor Fun, Drumming, Cooking, and Cuppa and a Chat in the Café. We have also launched our My Voice app which children can use to record any concerns they may have about their health, safety and well-being. We made these more accessible to all by distributing QR codes around school for quick access with their electronic tablets. The codes are also accompanied by symbol cards so other children can indicate that they need someone to listen to their worries. This helps inform us of any worries children may have including friendship breakdowns so we can pre-empt any possible bullying before it occurs. These all help children to 'shout out' in all the varied ways they can, and helps empower them to keep themselves safe and happy.

Hub 4 have run their annual **Palentines Project**, where they focus on 'Pals' rather than valentines, and sharing something nice and positive with them to show their gratitude for being a good friend. This widens the appreciation of relationships around children and so is more inclusive. This afternoon we have held our **Valentines Disco** which most of the children love, however for those for whom this is overwhelming, we also had quieter activities including Valentine's card making, sensory story / story massage, biscuit icing, fancy dress and inflatable instruments, and a variety of red objects and textures to explore e.g. play dough, petals and red rice.


