
Hello and welcome back this sunny Spring term. I hope you had a lovely couple of weeks break and your children are feeling refreshed and ready to learn lots of fun, new things this term. Explorers have been learning about what it's like in the forest, feeling the logs, twigs and new leaves and have had a 'barefoot walk' exploring textures with their feet; Investigators have been making 'Mountains' with their sensory cooking; Adventurers have been sharing and pairing up to support each other and using iPad Communication Aids to better express their needs, wants and ideas; some Towards Independence department students have been working on their Rebound trampoline skills and some have even earned TUMBLE badges, others worked at Beaudesert Farm, bottle feeding the kid goats and checking on the progress of our chicks that hatched in school last term (see page 3 for photos).

It's been a lovely start to the term as very high numbers of children and staff have returned healthy and happy. Our restrictions to help keep everyone safe still include staff wearing masks in all communal areas, in corridors and for close, personal care including feeding and changing. DfE advice is also that any staff feeling unwell stay off and avoid contact with others, and return only when their temperature is back to normal and they are feeling well; Adults testing positive are to stay off and not contact others for 5 days, children testing (or you think may be) positive are to stay off and not contact (non-essential) others for 3 days.
